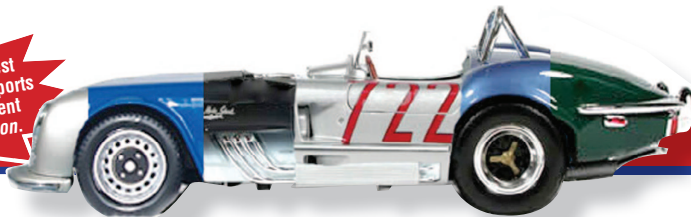

- **Club and Marque Display** ... all the favourite sports and classics on display. Sunday 20/5/12. Class awards and prize for the Best Club/Marque Display. Includes a People's Choice award. The 37th year of this display.
- **Interclub Team Regularity Championship (Pacemasters)** ... teams of 4 cars and drivers, each team representing their Club, will compete on the track on Saturday 19/5/12. Competition rules apply. Supporters are encouraged to attend. The winners will be crowned The Pacemasters (at the Awards, 20/5/12). This is the first year for this event.
- **Shannons Concours d'Elegance** ... the beautiful and the bold. Sunday 20/5/12. A limited display and rigorous judging of outstanding sports and classic cars.
- **ByDesign Concours de Facsimile** ... a Concours opportunity for replica and recreated classics. A World first? Who knows? In 2011 the event claimed a World first, the very first Circuit d'Elegance, so in 2012 what else could be expected?
- **Radum Restoration Theatre** ... the restoration of a sports car, by Queensland apprentices. The finished car will be raffled, and some lucky person will take it home. Proceeds to the Spinal Injuries Association. Over two days, Saturday 19/5 and Sunday 20/5/12.
- **Circuit d'Elegance** ... finalists in the two Concours will be escorted in victory laps around the racetrack. Sunday 20/5/12. Classics on the racetrack. A great photo opportunity.
- **Sports and Classic Car Auction** ... in the pits on Sunday 20/5/12. Conducted by Pickles Auctions.
- **'Happy Laps'** ... at the end of the day on 20/5/12 enthusiasts will have an opportunity to use the track, with normal safety considerations and no extra charge.
- **Award Ceremony** ... on Sunday 20/5/12, all winners from the two days will be the stars of a presentation ceremony at a dais on the track.
- **Stalls and Displays** ... the leading parts and service providers to the classic car community, and local sports car manufacturers.
