

Jag Qld club run – 19th March 2024 – Rick Blundell

1. 10.30 - Meeting point – coffee break - Bucks Bakery, Cribb St Landsborough. Limited tables and chairs so first come first served. Make sure to try the Lamingtons.



2. 11.30 – Depart from Bucks Bakery, follow Cribb St North to Old Gympie Rd. Turn left into Old Gympie Rd. Follow Old Gympie Rd to roundabout and take 2nd exit onto Old Gympie Road and follow to traffic lights at Peachester Rd. Turn right into Peachester Rd and follow this Rd to Peachester. (approx. 15 km)
3. 11.50 – Just after the coffee shop at Peachester and before the primary school Turn left into Commissioner flat Rd and follow this Rd until it meets the Kilcoy Beerwah Rd. Turn left and follow the Kilcoy Beerwah Rd until it meets Highway 85. Turn left towards Woodford and drive onto D’Aguilar. (approx. 25km)
4. 12.15 – Turn right into Mount Mee Road at D’Aguilar and follow this Rd through Mt Mee until you come to Sellin Road on your right. Turn right into Sellin Rd until you get to “the Gantry” in the D’Aguilar National Park. (approx 21km). This is a steep climb from Delaney’s Creek to Mt Mee so make sure the older Jags/Daimlers are good to do this drive.
5. This will allow us to set up for lunch between 12.30 and 12.45.

Please note the National Park has toilets but no dedicated picnic tables so it would be wise to bring you own picnic table and chairs.

I may not be back from Melbourne for this run so if I am not in Landsborough at 10.30am Ralph Johnson will take the lead.
