To find the Information Centre, turn at the lights on Steve Irwin Way into GlassHouse. Reed St continues into Bruce Pde then Burgess St. Turn left into the information car park.

Leaving the car park we head to the Glasshouse Plantation Coffee Farm Cafe for a good cup of local coffee. Relax and enjoy morning tea featuring local seasonal produce as you take in the views of the nearby Glass House Mountains from the cafe deck.

Browse the farm shop and pick up your favourite Australian grown coffee to brew at home or indulge in delicious Mountain treats including macadamia nuts, dried pineapple, tea and honey. We will leave the Cafe at about 11 am.



Next stop a couple of kilometres down the track to the Glasshouse Mountains Lookout. Spend some time viewing our beautiful mountains and read the legends associated with the mountains

We will leave the lookout at about 11.30 am.

We should arrive at our BYO picnic destination, Mary Cairn Cross Park, at approximately 12.30 pm. If you do not want to BYO picnic you can purchase take aways at the Mountain View Cafe in the picnic area grounds.
