MacLeans Bridge Car Display at Belmont 2

MacLeans Bridge 2017



This year I put my name down to go to the MacLeans Bridge car display at the Queensland Rifle Range venue in Belmont south of Brisbane. I believe this is the second time it has been held at this location and I was interested to see what the new layout would be like. In the past, I have taken a car to the meeting at the village of MacLeans Bridge and also to Lakeside racetrack north of Brisbane but I hadn't been to Belmont before. During the week I got the E Type out of mothballs and gave it the once over to see that important things like engine oil, brake fluid and tyre pressure were OK and gave it a bit of a clean. I then started off early about 7.15am on a bright and sunny Sunday morning from home and eventually joined the flow of traffic along the M1 motorway. It was not long before I recognised Bryan and Helen White's XK8 coming up behind me, and as I was not in any hurry they gave me a toot and kept going past. I had been trawling behind a Triumph Stag which I decided was also going to Macleans Bridge and although I knew which exit to take on the Gateway Motorway I decided to just tag along behind. (I assumed he knew where he was going).

My first impression of the site was that it was huge. The entrance to the display area was probably about a Km from the road and going past the trees you came to a vast expanse of open fields ringed by grassy banks. Your senses were immediately accosted by the crack-crack of fire from the adjacent rifle and pistol ranges. Luckily they were in the distance! Tony Nelson from the Brisbane Register had previously sent parking details to all participants so I had a good idea where to go, and both he and Tony Herald were on hand to guide members into the correct parking slot. After getting out of my winter coat (I had the top down coming along) I had a short wander round to who else I knew from the club. I soon came across Tony Curtis who had come down with Col Galley's group, Lloyd Andersen and Clive Arnold from the Brisbane Register, Merv Jackson who now had the ex-Wes Evers much modified yellow XJS and Barry Cranitch from the Sunshine Coast, and Alan Buller from the Darling Downs Register. I also met up with John and Monica Tupicoff who had brought their black racing Mark 7 along. It was good to talk to them as John had been the club President when we joined the club. Next to the Mark 7 was Ron and Bobby Braziers lovely Mark 9 and I spent some time chewing the fat with them. Seated opposite was John and Coleen Davis with their Open XJS and Peter Reynolds with his XJS coupe.

It was now time for coffee and cake which I had while talking to Colin and Wilhelmina Lee. They were parked behind me in their XKR. We had known each other in the Brisbane Register when Col had restored an E Type. After morning tea I took a tour of the area to look at some superb cars. As expected there was a great turn-out of British cars such as MGs, Triumphs, Austins and Austin Healys, Rovers, Sunbeam Alpines, Morgans and Minis. There was a group of European cars including Volvo P1800s, Citroens and Fiats and American cars were represented with Ford GT40s and Cobras, Mustangs, Chryslers, a Cadillac plus two beautifully restored early model convertible Packards. Mazda was well represented with a large number of MX5s, both new and not so new. We had a great roll-up of Jaguars. As planned we were to have 39 cars including 13 E Types, and although I didn't count them there a large collection of Jaguar models including an F Type, some Mk2s, XJs, XJSs, S Types, XK8s, XKRs, an XK150, a Mk 7 and Mk 9 as well a beautiful 1939 SS. Col Galley had a number of his cars on site including Jaguars and an Alvis.

There was much talk between drivers on the various aspects of their cars. I had an interesting talk with a Porsche driver who did not seem fussed about DIY working on Porsches and another driver who was trying to sort out why his early BMW was missing all the time even though he seemed to have done all the things I could suggest. A congenial lunch was had with Bryan and Helen White and Tony Herald before another look around the area. Then it was time to pack up for the trip home. The fields are close to the Gateway Motorway and the trip was uneventful except for the exceptional heavy traffic heading south on the M1. It was a good day out in the sunshine!


