This is planned for $28^{th} - 30^{th}$ August at a cost of \$520 double or \$380 single. The cost includes accommodation for two nights, a hot breakfast with choices (no buffet) each morning and two course dinners for two evenings. The restaurant can now cater for up to 39 guests as restrictions have been eased. The motel was chosen for meals as there were no other large venues open in Kingaroy at the time the organisers visited the town.

The drive up is planned as a leisurely run but members must bring BYO morning tea and lunch on the Friday as there is unlikely to be any venues open. Saturday will be taken up with a visit to the local historic museum followed by lunch at the Kingsley Grove Winery. The winery advised its specialty is wood fired pizzas. For Sunday we will have brunch at the local Lavender farm before heading for home. If members wish to explore the surrounds on their own there are several drives of approximately 2 hours.

There are 25 rooms preliminarily booked at the motel, all on the ground floor. Others are available if numbers increase.
