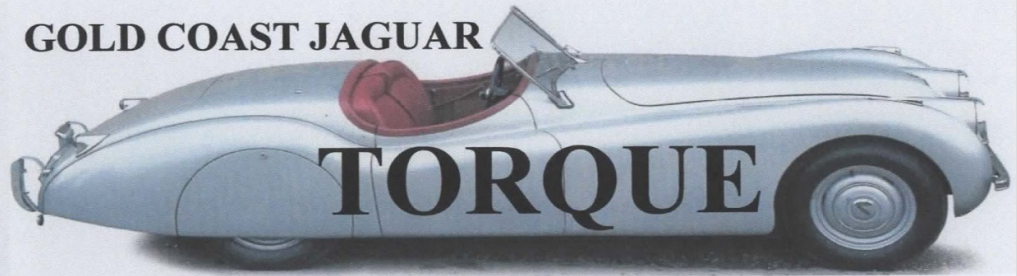

WILL BE POSTPONED UNTIL THEN.**

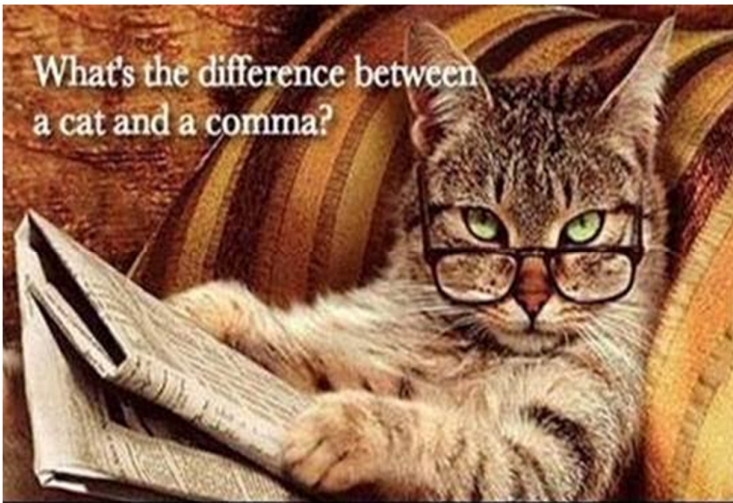
Next Meeting

The next meeting planned for Monday 30th March 2020 at the Hinterland Hotel, 53 Station Street Nerang has been cancelled.



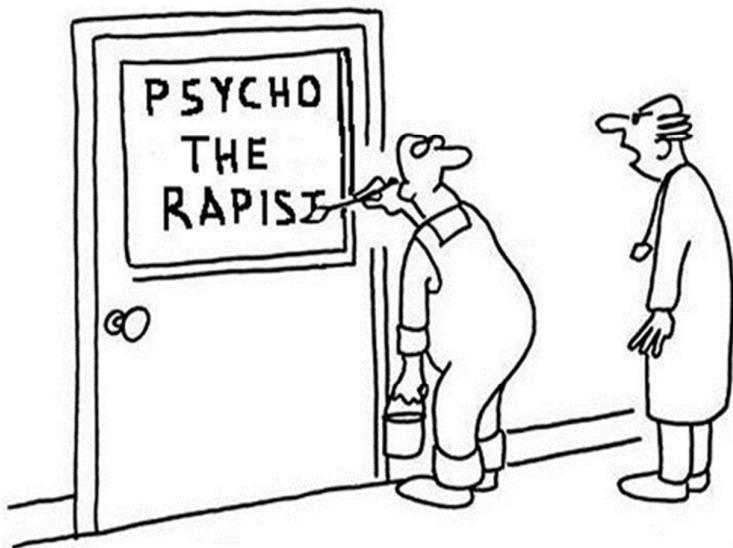

General Business:

The Chairman gave a brief summary of a complaint which was received from Karen Herald, directed to the Queensland Committee, and copied to all local Registers. It related to the archiving of perpetual trophies, but specifically to the archiving of the Danielle Herald Memorial Trophy. The concerns were about the lack of consultation with the Herald Family, which the President, to his credit, admitted. The meeting was advised that the Gold Coast Register had sent a reply directly to Queensland, after consultation with several members. Jim Reid (President, JDCQ) was then invited to the floor to explain further the background to the situation that has arisen. A very emotional and heart-felt debate followed, with a proposal from the Secretary for a solution to resolve this issue, i.e. that the Herald Family take over the total control of the Danielle Herald Memorial Trophy, including maintenance, transport, etc., quite independently of the Club. This was seen as satisfying all parties involved and was agreed to by the Gold Coast members. The President said he would take this proposal to the Queensland Committee, and advise us on their response. None of the correspondence was read, but is available from the Secretary, should members wish to see it.

Other General Business related to a question from the floor, asking if we still require a cheque account, as we now have internet banking, and can therefore possibly avoid the monthly bank fee (quoted in Correspondence above).

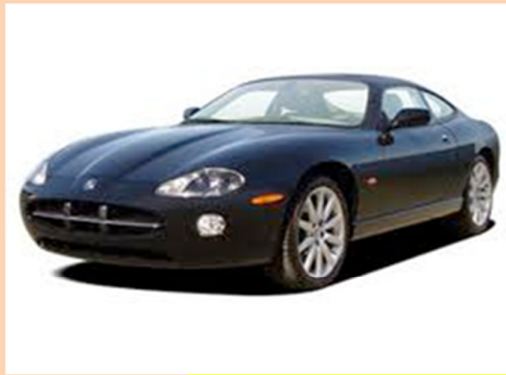
