At 7.51pm the Committee Members of 2023 were stood down, with Tom Ross taking the floor. He called on the opening of the 37th AGM of the Jaguar Gold Coast Register. He noted the late Club Patron Ron Gaudion and original founding member had passed away; Ron having formed the Register after moving from Melbourne.

Tom thanked the Committee for their efforts and for the year's activities. The nomination forms were then checked by Dick Kennedy and Roy Bayliss, and later found to be correct. Tom called for a vote of special thanks to Di Cooper for her efforts in the Registry and for the Club in Queensland generally.

Guests and Apologies were as per meeting. Tom then sought confirmation of the Minutes of the last AGM, dated 28 November 2022. Taken as read. Nothing arising.
