Vale Helen White



Sadly, Helen White, wife of the late Bryan White passed away on 2nd February 2026 after a prolonged illness. Helen and Bryan were Life Members of the Jaguar Drivers Club of Queensland, contributed greatly to the JDCQ and, in their time in Sydney, the Jaguar Drivers Club of Australia (NSW).

It is difficult to separate the deeds of both Helen and Bryan since they always worked as a pair.

They were members of the JDCA for many years from the late 70's with Bryan serving as their President for two years from 1983 and again for two years from 1987. During this time, they developed an interest in concours, resulting in preparing their Jaguar 240 (Mk2) to achieve an outright win in the JDCA state concours in 1981 and in the State and National Jaguar Rally Concours in 1982. Their Jaguar 240 was Helen's daily driver and the preparation of the 240 was carried out by Bryan and Helen with Helen specializing in preparing the interior.

Bryan and Helen moved to Brooklet inland from Byron Bay in 1993 taking over a lovely 5 acre property. It wasn't long before a sizeable shed was built allowing them to house, at times, 3 or 4 Jaguars, two Cadillacs, a Mustang and a daily driver Subaru. Helen was a passionate gardener and spent many hours converting a rambling stretch of hillside in front of the house into a beautiful native garden. Helen loved nothing better than spending time in her garden and did so until her last years there.

On moving to Northern NSW they joined the JDCQ in 1993, and became involved in the Gold Coast Register's activities during which time Bryan served as Register Chairman for a couple of years, travelling up from Northern NSW for meetings as well as contributing in other ways.

They were regular National Jaguar Rally attendees in all states, and in 2010 Bryan, with support from Helen, took over direction of the National Rally on the Gold Coast. Helen's expertise in judging, of interiors, was put to use many times for JDCQ events and also for many years when they judged the entrants in the Summerland Car Show, a club they also belonged to.
