Treasurers Report: The treasurer reported the following balances in the accounts: Working Account \$3981.89, Savings Account \$12,241.06 Total \$16,222.95. The balance in the account this time last year was approximately \$23,000.

Past Events: John and Lorraine Hornabrook led our club down to the Mt Alford Hotel via Canungra for lunch. Every one said that they had a great time and drove on some roads that they had not used before. Meals were good and the beer cold.

Future Events : 10th November Picnic Run – JDČQ joins with the MG's for a combined run to picturesque Mt Stinson in the hinterland.

Editors Report: Our editor Rob Kup-Ferroth has indicated he will not be nominating for the position for next year. The Chairman used this opportunity to set out the benefits of publishing the newsletter on the website. The JDCQ webmaster will do this for free, removing the onerous and expensive task of publishing, printing and mailing a hard copy to every member. Content can be also included in the Jaguar Driver magazine. The Acting Secretary suggested that instead of one editor, various committee members without portfolio could share the tasks of photographer, article writer, event co-ordinator etc. and submit these individually to the Webmaster who would log them on the website for all to see. That handful of members without internet access could receive a printed copy downloaded from the website. General Business: JDCQ Club President Alan Hilless addressed the meeting and urged members to stand for the committee for the Register, but also to consider standing for the JDCQ Committee to steer the club into the future. This committee meets 6 times per year to decide overall strategies and policies for the club. The Chairman proposed the first meeting of 2014 be held on the 1st Monday in February to avoid the public holiday for Australia Day. The meeting unanimously agreed.

John Davis also suggested that the meeting could be held elsewhere as a more social event instead of each meeting being at Sunshine Jaguar. The Chairman expressed his reticence to leave Sunshine Jaguar's venue and others spoke about potential cost of renting a room connected with a hotel or golf club. It was decided to leave this to the committee for next year.

Ron Gaudion announced that the speaker he had lined up for the Christmas Party had unfortunately passed away. Ron has graciously consented to present the keynote speech instead. Ron also mentioned that the register had formally met at the Commercial Hotel in Nerang, but that there would probably be a cost involved for the room should we return there.

Terry Cooper rose to speak about the interest in a mid-week run and that Col Galley with his Kirkfare Classics display of classic Jaguars would welcome a visit from the Gold Coast Register. Terry pointed out that a mid-week runs avoids the crowds, packed restaurants and traffic congestion associated with weekend events. The meeting welcomed this initiative and once again put it over for consideration by the committee next year.

The meeting concluded with the drawing of the raffle, the Champagne being won by the First Lady Lorraine H, the bottle of Merlot by editor Rob, and the Cadbury Roses by the vice chair's partner Julia G. Accusations of rigging were summarily dismissed, and the meeting closed at 8.30pm with the Chairman thanking Sunshine Jaguar for use of the facility.


