From here we shall continue South popping up for skyline views on a route that keeps us in the City of Gold Coast. Our venue for Lunch is University Club Restaurant at Bond University. Besides the excellent food at the Club Restaurant and the ambiance of the Campus, we have arranged a special Corrigan Walk Art Tour after the meal. This is the largest private collection of indigenous art on public display and features the works of our most celebrated and revered indigenous artists. We will have a guide to explain everything. Dr Corrigan AM has put together this collection over the last 20 years, is a local resident, and supporter of the 'Arts'. Dr Patrick Corrigan AM was appointed to the Board of the Gold Coast Arts Centre in 1996 and is the longest serving board member with many paintings donated to the Art Gallery. Born in China he began his career in the transport industry in the 1960's and by the mid 70's he was head of several freight companies. Pat began his love affair with collecting art and art books in his 30's, and meeting artists and supporting their early careers, publishing books, commissioning sculpture and encouraging others to 'give' has all been part of his life in art. Pat is a recipient of the Keys to the City of the Gold Coast.
